


# Best Alphington Walks

## Walk 1 Alphington Brook Ford (1.9 miles)




This pleasant but short pub walk starts at Alphington church and follows the <u>Green Circle</u>

(a circular route around Exeter) until it turns into Crab Lane possibly dating back to the Middle Ages.

Charles Dickens bought Mile End House, Church Road, for his father.





# Alphington Walks




#### Walk 3 Alphington to Exeter circular (6.6 miles)



A delightful circular 7 mile hike to Exeter, using footpaths and quiet lanes. It follows the Green Circle into Barley Valley Mature Reserve & Exeter bypassing all major roads then continues along the canal into Exeter Quay with ample opportunities to take a break.
