


### Walk 1 Owlacombe Cross (3.9 miles)




This is one of our most popular walks following part of the Dartmoor Way along the river Ashburn into Whiddon Scrubbs.

Bowermans nose was once thought to be idolised by ancient tribes.






Buckfastleigh, a medieval market town, is a popular tourist attraction. The name implies 'a place where buck and deer were kept'.



A castle, pub and river walk combined through one of the most magical landscapes in Devon!




Dartmeet is a popular picnic destination in the centre of Dartmoor.





This is the popular daffodil walk along the river Teign.












### Best Emsworthy Mire Walks



### Walk 1 Emsworthy Mire (1 mile)




A short and pleasant rural walk from Saddle Tor Car Park South around the Nature Reserve.

Emsworthy Mire is a nature reserve near Widecombe. In early summer, the fields are a dazzling purple from the flowers of thousands of bluebells.





# Best Elephants Nest Walk





This is a must do pub walk if you are in the area.





# Fernworthy Walks




### Walk 1 Reservoir and ancient circle (3.6 miles)

Fernworthy is a popular place for walkers enjoying quiet woodland walks, the views of the reservoir or its many archaeological sites.







During the bronze age Grimspound, made of granite blocks, enclosed 24 hut circles, some of the oldest surviving buildings in Great Britain.












### Hembury Woods Best Walks

Hembury Castle ( signed 'fort') is one of the most serene forts you can imagine , with grass carpeted paths flanked by lush fauna, a secret well kept!





### Walk 1 Harford Church & Moorland (7.8 miles)





Gateway to Dartmoor, Ivybridge is perfect for nature lovers with delightful riverside trails and lush countryside views .





This delightful walk takes you into a most unspoilt and dramatic part of Devon following the river Bovey.






### Walk 1 Mary Tavy To Brent Tor (8.6 miles)

This delightful 8+ miles hike climbs steadily out of Mary Tavy following part of the <u>Dartmoor Way</u> on the Brentor Road.



A few years ago, this delightful village on the edge of Dartmoor stepped into the limelight when scenes of 'War Horse' were filmed near by.





# Moretonhampstead Walks




### Walk 1 Cranbrook Castle (4.7 miles)

Moretonhamstead, gateway to Dartmoor, is an ideal town for walkers to explore the lush edge of the moor. The locals refer to it as 'Moreton'.







### Walk 1 Around New Bridge (1.9 miles)




An ideal walk for a picnic or a paddle in the river.



### Walk 1 Moretonhampstead (5 miles)





Princetown offers the walker spectacular views of Dartmoor's almost volcanic landscapes.





This is a delightful but somewhat demanding trail through a lush oak woodland with a beautiful stretch along the river Meavy.


Shaugh Bridge, where the river Meavy joins the river Plym. has long been a favourite centre for walks.






### Walk 1 Brentmoor & Shipley Bridge (5.9 miles)

Nestled on the edge of Dartmoor, South Brent offers a cozy village vibe and stunning moorland walks with dramatic scenery following the meandering River Avon.





South Zeal and its surroundings are steeped in history with its old pubs(!), medieval plots and a chapel with two clock faces joined by a single shaft.





Warren House Inn was built in 1845 opposite a house, now destroyed, which queched the thirst of many a tin miner.






