

### Walk 1 Wide views & site of Roman Fort (6.9 miles)

This is a most delightful walk into a totally unspoilt part of Devon.clt starts in Bampton and steadily climbs to Bampton Down along an old packhorse path to Exeter, with stunning views on either side of the bridle paths.


Bampton is a charming Saxon town north of Tiverton boasting several pubs and an old motte and bailey castle.


Burlescombe grew in importance when during the 19th century superior limestone was mined in quarries nearby.






A small village south of Tiverton known for its pub and the Burn Valley nearby.



Calverleigh is a charming and peaceful village with a manor house called Calverleigh Court.





Explore winding lanes, ancient footpaths, and green pastures that lead to breathtaking views over the surrounding hills.


The name means a settlement with a church (cyrig ton). Fitzpaine was added later in the 13th century.




This fairly easy river walk includes a steady climb and descent.



### Walk 1 River Yeo (3.3 miles)




More Details & Walks



# Walk 1 Medland Manor (3.5 miles)




A very pleasant and not too strenuous (dog) walk in a peaceful and remote part of Devon following quiet lanes and public footpaths.

The route includes several stiles and route takes you along the back of Medland Manor. The original 13th century building was burnt down; it belonged to Henry de Stanewe.






A most varied 5+ mile hike, partly following the Tarka trail to the river Taw and crossing Eggesford Forest.




### Walk 1 Forest and stream Walk (1.1 miles)

Eggesford Forest, managed by the Forestry Commission, is an ideal centre for short walks.








# Walk 1 Grand Western Canal (2.8 miles)









This truly delightful and relatively easy walk through a completely unspoilt part of Devon has a pub the Half Moon as a convenient halfway stop.






A pleasant if not muddy country walk through an unspoilt tranquil part of Devon with many views to enjoy.

The tranquil rolling landscape around Kennerleigh has changed little since the Middle Ages.






Oakford, on the edge of Exmoor, makes an ideal centre for exploring hidden undisturbed valleys and magnificent woods.

The 'Pomeroy' part of the name comes from the de Pomeroy family, a prominent Norman family who settled in Devon after the Norman Conquest of 1066.




Raddon Hills offer the walker on this 5 mile hike some of the best views of Dartmoor and Haldon, ideal for a picnic.




A great and gentle walk taking in a disused railway and canal known for its fauna and wildlife.





The area around Witheridge is mainly farmland with large rolling fields.


