

Best Ashburton Walks




Walk 1 Owlacombe Cross (3.9 miles)




This is one of our most popular walks following part of the Dartmoor Way along the river Ashburn into Whiddon Scrubbs.

Ashburton, an old stannary (tin mining) town, boasts numerous pubs and a variety of old-fashioned shops.





It's quite remarkable that during WWII this area had an 'airstrip' lit up at night as a decoy for Exeter Airport.





Bampton is a charming Saxon town north of Tiverton boasting several pubs and an old motte and bailey castle.



An easy and popular walk from Bovey Tracey's main Car Park along the river Bovey and a disused railway returning via footpaths.





An easy and enjoyable circular walk exploring this most peaceful landscape.




Buckfastleigh, a medieval market town, is a popular tourist attraction. The name implies 'a place where buck and deer were kept'.



Walk 1 Medland Manor (3.5 miles)




A very pleasant and not too strenuous (dog) walk in a peaceful and remote part of Devon following quiet lanes and public footpaths.

The route includes several stiles and route takes you along the back of Medland Manor. The original 13th century building was burnt down; it belonged to Henry de Stanewe.






This pub walk to Coombe Cellars crosses an old rolling landscape with superb views of the river Teign.




Walk 1 Dartington Hall (3.4 miles)






A pleasant short walk exploringHayne Valley and Flashdown Wood, South of Eggesford.




This delightful (revised) country walk starts at Escot Park and leads via Taleford to Cadhay House, a Tudor mansion open to the public on certain Fridays.


Escot Park is a hidden gem for walkers and those who love open spaces dotted with large trees - you can park free of charge .




More Details & Walks

This pleasant walk starts in Feniton and follows the Old Route of the LSWR Branch Line, along the Otter.




This peaceful walk is virtually cyclist free and culminates in a track through a rich forest similar to those found in Switzerland or Germany.




This delightful walk starts on the outskirts of Newton Poppleford and crosses the Otter via a footbridge into Harpford village.

Walking through a most dramatic and ancient wood near Harpford containing unique fauna.





Oakford, on the edge of Exmoor, makes an ideal centre for exploring hidden undisturbed valleys and magnificent woods.




A popular woodland walk entering part of the Wetlands, a conservation area .




Walk 1 Porlock Weir to Culbone church (5.0 miles)


A great 5 mile (dog) hike through woods & along spectacular cliffs with extensive views.

Porlock, a charming village in Somerset, and Porlock Weir, a quiet little harbour nearby, are both very popular centres for walkers.







Some very old and tall trees are found in these woods (NW of Exeter) which during the Middle Ages provided valuable building timber.





A delightful trail to explore the English Riviera's coast with all it's glamour.


The quay, it is believed, was built by monks who lived in a monastery near a Tor (craggy peak) - see Torre Abbey below.





Walk 1 Torrington Common, river & Obelisk (3.5 miles)





Great Torrington, second oldest Saxon market town in devon, makes an ideal centre for walking offering extensive views of a dramatically meandering Torridge.



Totnes buzzes with bohemian spirit, historic charm, and a unique blend of indie shops and medieval streets.


